El Regional Museo Rayo schedule and visit

ROLDANILLO. From today, Museo Rayo will hold two new exhibitions by Colombian painter, Carlos Jacanamijoy, and the second video art exhibition by Panamanian artists Donna Conlon and Jonathan Harker. In addition, work by master painter Alejandro Obregón will be exhibited within the framework of the Obra Huésped programme. According to the review written by management at the museum in Roldanillo, Jacanamijoy is one of the foremost Colombian painters to have emerged in the final decade of the 20th century. 'His rationale has focussed on nature through symbolic reinterpretation of the national forest. He was born in Santiago, Putumayo, into an important Inga community family,' the document points out. It mentions that 'it is the first time that Museo Rayo has held an exhibition of the artist's large-format work. The previous one was a display of graphics on paper when the artist was residing in New York.'
