<u>Daniel Buren</u>, Peinture acrylic blanche sur tissue rayé blanc et orange, 1974, at <u>Bortolami</u>

Excellence—Buren's stripes are seen often in his installations.

Aaron Curry, Hunkulf, 2013, at Almine Rech

This sculpture has a beautiful tension in its design.

Wang Guangle, Coffin Paint 141027, 2014, at Beijing Commune

Chosen for the grays in his abstract "Coffin Paint" series. I like the horizontal line that intersects this composition.

Zak Kitnick, Quick and Easy, 2014, at Clifton Benevento

This artist makes sculptures that reorganize industrial products and procedures. "Quick and Easy" is like a <u>Warhol</u> Brillo Box made transparent, which can be considered the next turn of the screw.

John Bock, Helmut Berger, 2014, at Anton Kern Gallery

The collage materials are a nice interplay and have a 1940s vibe.

Clever, with elements that echo Cornell.
