Over the winter, a selection of works from the collection is presented in the West Wing of Louisiana Museum of Modern Art. *Parrhesia* is the title of [Franz West](#)'s sculpture group on display in the second exhibition gallery and is also an ancient Greek word meaning boldness, openness, liberality.

Focusing on 21st-century art, the exhibition explores the interplay of artistic disciplines – film, photography, sculpture, installation and painting.

The aim is for the works to exist on their own terms and not be confined to an art-historical school or narrative. As always with art, connections naturally arise between the works. The viewer sees to that in open and engaging interaction with the art.
